

# IMMIGRANTS IN INDIANA



Indiana is home to over **350,000 immigrants**, **5.3%** of all **6.7 million people** living in the state.




Over 38% of Indiana's foreign-born population lives in Indianapolis.2 As of 2016, more than 63,000 lawful permanent residents living in Indiana were eligible to naturalize.3

### 92,000 **UNDOCUMENTED**

60% of undocumented immigrants in Indiana have been living in the U.S. for 10+ years.

#### 174,000 **CHILDREN**

Indiana is home to about 10,000 Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) recipients and over 2,600 Temporary Protected Status (TPS) holders. An additional 1,200 Dreamers without DACA live in Indiana. Without a legislative solution, all of these individuals are or may soon become susceptible to deportation.

of Indiana residents — including 56% of Republicans — believe DACA recipients and other Dreamers should be allowed to stay in the U.S.

of Indiana residents believe all undocumented immigrants should be allowed to stay in the U.S., including 52% of Republicans. 9

## Immigrants in Indiana Are Working

Immigrants in Indiana aged 16+ account for 6.1% of the state's total workforce. 10 Immigrants in Indiana are also more likely to participate in the workforce:

About 66% of the state's immigrants are in the workforce, compared to 64% of the state's native-born population. 11

Immigrant-owned businesses in Indiana employed 58,000 workers in 2016. 20,000 of Indiana's immigrants are entrepreneurs. 12



Immigrant spending power in Indiana added up to \$7.2 billion in 2017. 13



Immigrants account for nearly 14% of all Indiana workers employed in STEM fields. 15

Indiana had nearly 10,800 positions certified for H-1B specialty workers in 2016. 27% of these workers were computer systems analysts, followed by software developers (11%) and computer programmers (8%). 16
